DONOR FUNDED CNA SCHOOL EDUCATING TOMORROW'S CARETAKERS TODAY

Thanks to donors like **YOU**, the HSHS St. Mary's CNA School provides opportunities for tomorrow's health care workers!

HSHS St. Mary's Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) School is helping to prepare students for employment as nursing assistants. The CNA School is designed for those looking to advance their career as a member of the health care team working in direct patient care.

The school has a unique approach wherein the learning and training environments are based in our local hospitals, where the

students, upon graduation, immediately transition to working as a nursing assistant.

The program offers students the opportunity to learn the skills necessary to provide direct care under the supervision of a licensed nurse. Students participate in classroom sessions, hands-on labs and clinical experiences to develop the knowledge, skills and abilities to provide the safe, compassionate patient care that HSHS is known for.

"Becoming a CNA is a great steppingstone for anyone interested in nursing," said

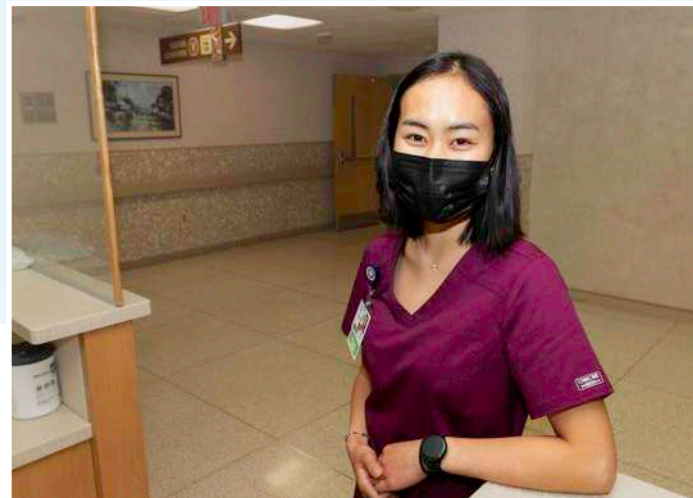
Emily Halla, DNP, MS, BSN, RN, HSHS St. Mary's CNA School Primary Instructor. "Working as a CNA is a great starting point to learn health care basics, terminology and processes."

The program follows all federal and state regulations for nurse-aide training programs. It is approved by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services as an official nurse-aide training program. Upon successful completion of the program, students are eligible to take the Wisconsin Nursing Assistant Competency Exam and work at a HSHS Wisconsin hospital as CNAs with the opportunity to grow.

A program graduate shared the following when asked about their experience, "The CNA School was absolutely terrific. It was so nice to be able to get more of the one-on-one

learning, ask any questions I may have and learn with great teachers. They truly care about you in this class and make sure you are prepared to take on the job of a CNA."

The HSHS St. Mary's CNA School has a 92% pass rate and a **100%** pass rate on the state exam. The program has helped to expand the pool of nursing assistants during a time of health care worker shortages. Thank you for supporting the future of health care right here in **YOUR** community.

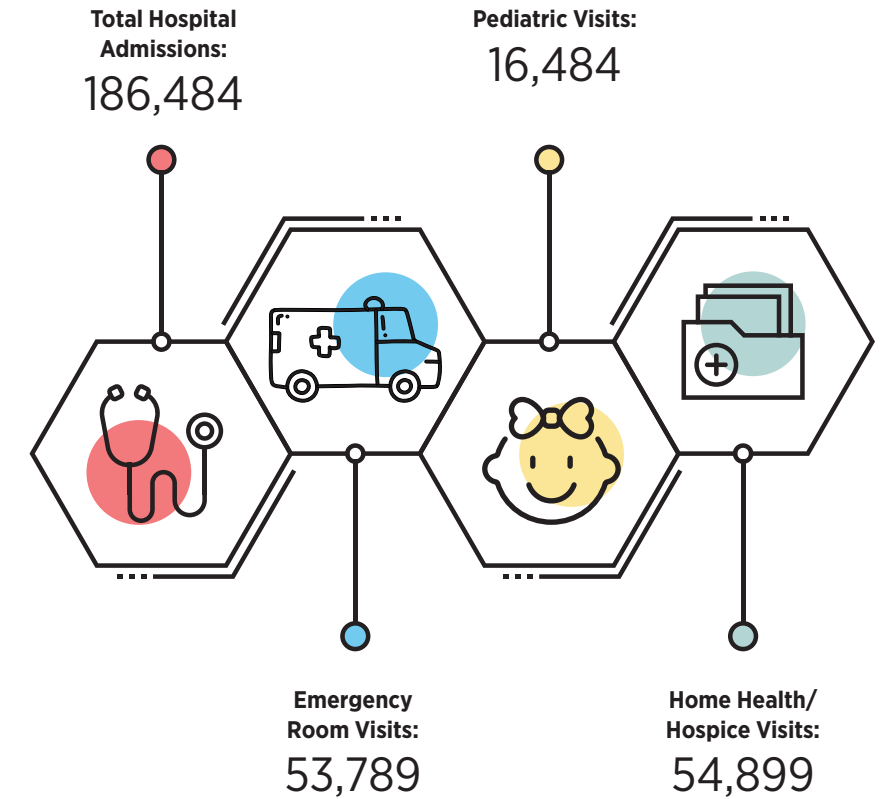

Dahlin Family Leaves a Legacy

Alyce Dahlin and her late husband, Bernie, have always had HSHS St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center close to their heart. "Bernie and I were married at St. Mary's Hospital," said Alyce Dahlin. Bernie was being treated for burns two weeks prior to their wedding so they decided to take their vows at the hospital.

The Dahlins are pillars of philanthropy in the Greater Green Bay community. Unfortunately, in the spring of 2020, Bernie passed away but that did not stop Alyce from carrying on their legacy and the love they shared for supporting the hospital.

During the initial stages of the pandemic, she was made aware of the nursing shortage that was occurring. "There was a shortage of nurses during the pandemic, and even now today, we still do not have enough," said Alyce. She called the HSHS St. Vincent/St. Mary's Foundation and asked if there was anything she could do to help, and how. That is when she was told about the HSHS St. Mary's Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) School.

For Alyce, the next step was a "no brainer", especially given the love she and Bernie shared for the hospital. She decided to contribute a leadership level gift in support of the CNA School. "I felt it would help someone consider going into the nursing profession, during a time of great need."
