We might think we are nurturing our garden, but many times, it's the garden that is really nurturing us. One recent patient and avid gardener found true comfort in the rooftop garden at HSHS St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center last spring.



Kirk Becker was considered to many near and dear to him as a master chef and baker, starting his culinary career being trained by his father, and ended up progressing to the kitchen of HSHS St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center. After several years he decided

to make a change and pursue his dream of working with technology. It was at the hospital that his computer skills were recognized as he worked as part of the IT department for many years to come, totaling his time with HSHS more than 30 years.

Fast forward 13 years later and he found himself back in a familiar place, but this time he was not cooking or working on computers. Kirk was being treated on the fifth floor of HSHS St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center for chronic pancreatitis, an extremely painful disease. After countless tests and cancelled surgeries, his condition was getting worse. Shortly thereafter he lost his ability to digest food, and his condition quickly progressed to gastroparesis. His caregivers at the hospital continued to treat him with kindness and compassion during his long stay.

"The team at St. Mary's did everything possible to bring him back to full health," said Elaine, his sister, who stood by his side as much as possible. After two months in the hospital the nurses on the fifth floor learned a lot about him, his love for cooking, technology and most importantly gardening.

Kirk, in his spare time, was a volunteer gardener, as he lived near Murphy Park where he routinely would take care of the flowers. One of the nurses treating him knew about his love for gardening, and on his last day at the hospital, took him to the rooftop garden on the third floor. "He was so

moved by this gesture, that he cried tears of appreciation and asked that we use some of his assets to support the garden," stated Elaine. A few days later, Kirk passed away at Elaine's woodland home up north, right in his favorite spot, her deck overlooking nature.

Thanks to donors like YOU, Kirk had a space where he could go to escape the pain and discomfort he was going through during his illness, which in-turn allowed Kirk's family to make their decision even easier. After Kirk's passing, his family decided to establish a fund for the rooftop garden at HSHS St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center.



"Even though he is gone from this earthly existence, we know his legacy will continue with the rooftop garden, may it be a place of peace for many others that deal with such chronic illnesses," said Elaine.

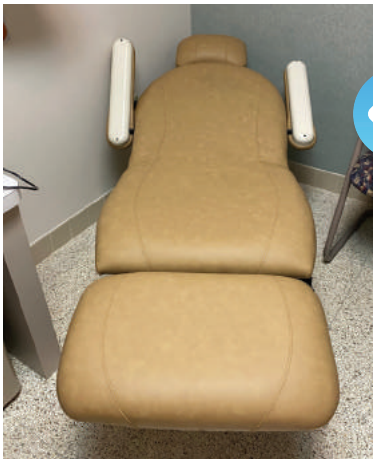
Strength in Numbers

Here is a quick look back at the some of the impact you made in 2021:



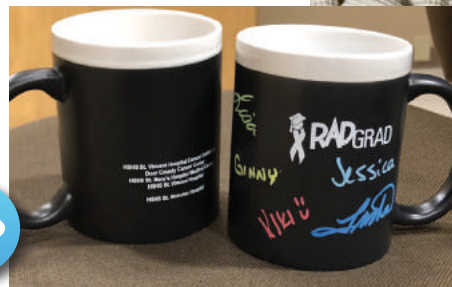
BARIATRIC PROCEDURE CHAIR
