*Audience: Registration, Nurses, Clinical Staff, Providers (Ambulatory, Emergency, and Hospital)*

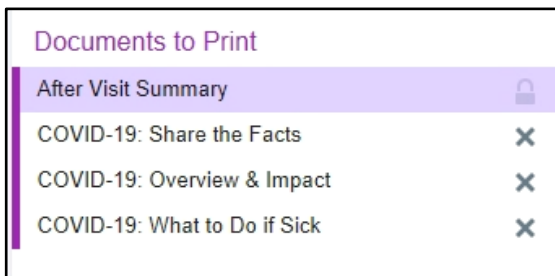
To help you make sure all patients are discharged with the most up-to-date information on COVID-19, the **After Visit Summary (AVS)** will now pull educational material directly from the CDC's website.

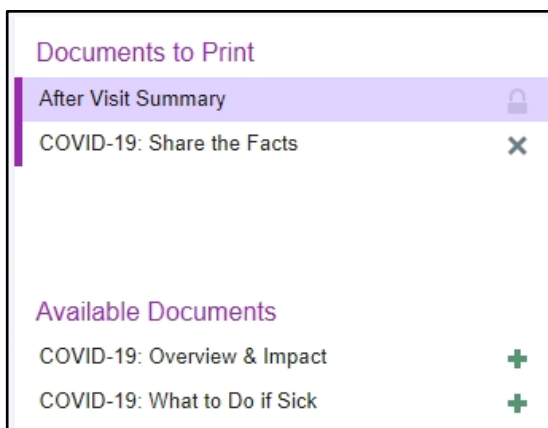
Because the information comes directly from regularly updated documents on the CDC's website, the educational materials reflect the current recommendations. If the patient has a preferred language of Spanish or Mandarin, the COVID-19 information will print off from the CDC website in those languages.

## Manually Print COVID-19 Information

Medical staff may choose to print the COVID-19 information for a patient instead of having the COVID-19 information print automatically. The COVID-19 information now has an X by the document.

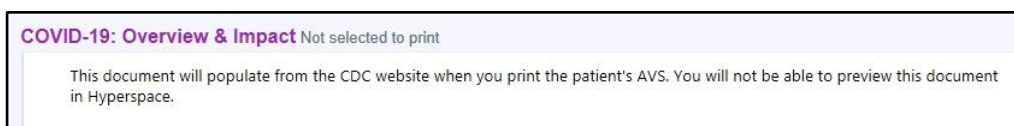


If the user only wants to print certain items, they can X out of the documents that do not need to be printed.



Medical staff can also select the green + to add the materials back to print with the **AVS** as needed.

**NOTE:** You are unable to preview the COVID-19 information before printing, as it will pull the current information listed on the CDC website.

## Steps to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 if you are sick

**FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW:** If you are sick with COVID-19 or think you might have it, follow the steps below to help protect other people in your home and community.

**Stay home except to get medical care**

- **Stay home:** People who are mildly ill with COVID-19 are able to recover at home. Do not leave, except to get medical care. Do

**Wear a facemask if you are sick**

- **If you are sick:** You should wear a facemask when you are around other people and before you enter a healthcare provider's office.
