Changes to the *After Visits Summaries* for the clinics, emergency, and hospital.

What is changing: *After Visits Summaries*(AVS) in the clinics, emergency, and the hospitals have been updated to automatically contain COVID-19 information from the CDC.

Patient instructions will display based on the patients preferred language - English, Spanish, or Mandarin. If the preferred language is not Spanish or Mandarin, then the instructions will display in English.

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) and you

What is coronavirus disease 2019?

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a respiratory illness that can spread from person to person. The virus that causes COVID-19 is a novel coronavirus that was first identified during an investigation into an outbreak in Wuhan, China.

What to do if you are sick with coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

If you are sick with COVID-19 or suspect you are infected with the virus that causes COVID-19, follow the steps below to help prevent the disease from spreading to people in your home and community.

Stay home except to get medical care

You should restrict activities outside your home, except for getting medical care. Do not go to work, school, or public areas. Avoid using public transportation, ride-sharing, or taxis.
