

IMPORTANT COVID-19 VACCINE INFORMATION



We are experiencing an overwhelming amount of calls about the availability of COVID-19 vaccine appointments at HSHS St. Elizabeth's Hospital. We appreciate everyone's patience as we try our best to distribute our allotted vaccines. The number of available appointments continues to be dependent on the number of vaccines.

We are currently only able to vaccinate the vulnerable elderly population who live in St. Clair County.

Please take a moment to read through what we are currently doing to serve our community and patients.



Current and future vaccination clinics will be by **APPOINTMENT ONLY. NO WALK INS ARE ALLOWED.**

APPOINTMENT NOTIFICATIONS: As vaccines become available, a direct text message and/or direct email from HSHS/MyChart is sent to a **limited group of eligible elderly residents of St. Clair County**, inviting them to make an appointment through their MyChart account. The number of people receiving the notice is based on the number of vaccines currently on site.

The invite **does not guarantee an appointment**, it is only a notification that more times have opened. It is tied to each person's individual medical record. **It cannot be shared or forwarded to be used by others.**

Our colleagues

have worked tirelessly for months and months to care for all of our patients and are stepping up further to distribute the vaccine.

Please do not call the hospital to ask for an appointment.

You cannot get on a "Waiting List" by calling St. Elizabeth's but here are 2 steps to take:

- 1** Visit your county health department's website. If they have an online form for vaccine notification for residents, please sign-up there.
- 2** If you are not an HSHS patient, you can still create a MyChart account to receive future vaccine communications based on eligibility criteria and future doses available. Creating a MyChart account **does not** automatically open vaccine appointments for you.

We ask the community to be patient as the distribution process continues to evolve and please do not share, post or email misinformation or rumors. Visit our COVID-19 Information page of our website, www.steliz.org, for updates.

PAST CLINICS: We have proudly administered over 5,000 doses to date. Recently, an issue with the online scheduling process briefly notified and allowed ineligible persons to make appointments. This has been corrected and we have been canceling those appointments.
