



## How does **FINANCIAL AID** add up?

**\$14,235**

This is the total cost for HSHS colleagues to attend the online St. John's College of Nursing RN-BSN program, but it is most likely not your number. **Let's see how financial aid can make a difference.**

**- \$2,500**



All current HSHS colleagues automatically qualify for a 20% tuition discount.

**- \$2,500**



Current HSHS colleagues also receive a scholarship once admitted into the program. No FAFSA® application required.\*

**- \$8,000**



Depending on FTE status, colleagues can earn up to \$8,000 (\$4,000 every 12 months) tuition reimbursement. Actual amount can be confirmed by HSHS Human Resources. The college invoices this directly to HSHS. No paperwork is necessary.

**\$1,235**

That's potentially more than \$13,000 in gift aid that is **NOT DEBT**, making a HSHS colleague's remaining total cost to attend St. John's College only \$1,235!

**But wait! There's more!**



\* Colleagues who do fill out the FAFSA also may qualify for federal and state grants in addition to federal loan programs. **These funds can be used toward housing, transportation and general expenses.**
