The GU/SJC Experience

First two years

- Students will enjoy all the rewards of classroom learning, a vibrant campus life and co-curricular activities on the GU campus.
- GU professors provide hands-on instruction in all prerequisite nursing courses.

Last two years (upon approval)

Specific upper-division nursing instruction from SJC faculty on the GU campus.

State-of-the-Art Simulation Resources

The partnership between GU and SJC gives students access to a mobile simulation unit on GU's campus and a simulation lab located at HSHS Holy Family Hospital. Simulation:

- Gives students hands-on experience in patient care via computerized, programmable manikins.
- Allows instructors to record student interactions with the manikins for later review and learning.
- Better prepares students for any situation in a clinical environment.
- Allows students to learn, practice and enhance skills in a no-risk, safe environment.



Clinicals and Practicums

Clinical experiences take place at HSHS Holy Family Hospital in Greenville and at other area HSHS hospitals.

Generous Scholarships Available

GU and SJC both offer scholarship programs. Donor-based and employment-based scholarships are available. Applications are accepted on an annual basis, and students will be notified what types of scholarships for which they can apply as they progress through the program. Tuition Reimbursement

New graduates who make a commitment to work for one of 15 Hospital Sisters Health System (HSHS) hospitals in Illinois and Wisconsin can apply for tuition reimbursement. In addition to the five locations in southern Illinois (Effingham, Greenville, Breese, Highland and O'Fallon), there are four HSHS hospitals in central Illinois (Springfield, Decatur, Litchfield and Shelbyville) and six in Wisconsin (Eau Claire, Chippewa Falls, Sheboygan, Oconto Falls and two in Green Bay).

The HSHS Education Assistance policy eligibility requirements, annual maximum benefit, work commitment and repayment obligations apply.
