An applicant must:

- Be a high school graduate, become a high school graduate in spring 2024, or have earned a GED.
- Be accepted and enrolled in a human health-care field at an accredited post-secondary school.
- Have a permanent address within **Chippewa County**

- Sacred Heart Hospital\*
- HSHS\*
- Prevea Clinics serving the Chippewa Valley\*\*

\*Colleague must maintain a minimum of 20 hours per week at St. Joseph's Hospital

\*\*Prevea colleague must maintain a minimum of 20 hours per week in Chippewa County

\*\*\*Provider must maintain a minimum of 20 hours per week at St. Joseph's Hospital

- Submissions should include, per Scholarship Guidelines:
  - Application
  - Personal Statement
  - Two Letters of Reference
  - Grade Transcript
