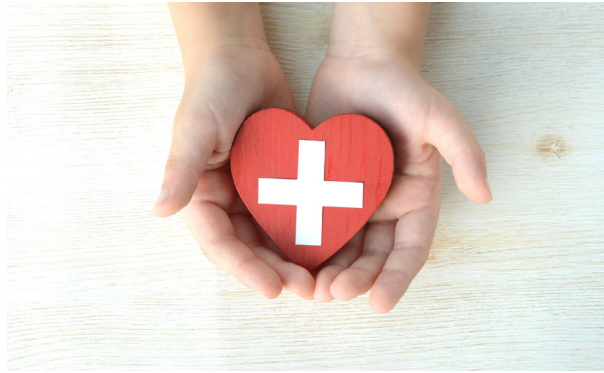


Thank you for your support of the HSHS St. Francis Hospital Auxiliary.

The HSHS St. Francis Auxiliary was founded on March 16, 1963 with a goal of promoting the hospital's interests and the welfare of its patients through volunteer service and fundraising.

Fundraising

Once a rolling cart with a few trinkets for purchase, the Auxiliary gift shop has become the largest single fundraising venture of the auxiliary. The Gift Shop coordinator and colleagues are responsible for every aspect of the shop, from selecting unique gift items to calculating each day's final sales. Their time is all volunteered.

Once or twice each year, the auxiliary sponsors book fairs. In addition, large fundraising events are planned and carried out by the auxiliary whenever the hospital has a special need. The efforts of the auxiliary have served all members of the community and have helped the hospital continue in its mission of serving all who come in need.



JVs

Each summer, young men and women ages 14-18 serve as junior volunteers throughout the hospital. The auxiliary coordinates this popular program.

Scholarships

The auxiliary proudly administers continuing medical education scholarships for students in accredited institutions of higher education who are seeking careers in the health care field.

Results

Today, the original group of 46 "pink ladies" have expanded to include more than 200 men and women who are members of the HSHS St. Francis Hospital Auxiliary. All have served the hospital through the years with their annual dues, countless fundraisers and innumerable hours of service. They have helped purchase equipment, pay for facility upgrades and supply additional items, all with the comfort and the benefit of the patients and community in mind. Since its inception, the auxiliary has donated approximately **\$400,000?** to HSHS St. Francis Foundaton. Their gifts have hlepeld purchase equipment for laboratory, cardiac rehabilitation, acute care, maternity, surgery, emergency and patient education. Donations include coloring books and crayons for children waiting in registration, and the group continues its "Books for Babies" tradition - supplying a new board book for every infant born at St. Francis Hospital.
