Hospital Sisters Health System; multiple new hires and new positions being

created in mission and leadership at a system and local level; and despite the challenges of the past few years, we are engaged in the same priorities of excellent patient care.

I am personally feeling renewed because of some work that we've been able to do this year. You have heard about our Charity Care over last Christmas season- 52 families in financial need received over \$250,000 in debt relief because of your generosity. Another new thing that has been incredibly rewarding is the partnership with Lakeshore Community Health for breast health examinations for women with financial hardship. I have never been so happy to receive bills in my mailbox as I see women taking the preventative measures to live their healthiest lives - again, because of your generosity.


